



IICRC Standards: AI Use Policy

IICRC prohibits the entry of its standards and related intellectual property (IP) into any form of artificial intelligence (AI) tools, such as ChatGPT. Additionally, creating derivatives of IICRC published and draft standards using AI is also prohibited. If a licensee violates this AI Use Policy, IICRC will suspend their access to its intellectual property, and further legal action will be considered.

This policy ensures that AI is not used to redistribute or create new, non-compliant versions of IICRC's copyrighted work.

For Standards Development: The IICRC prohibits the use of generative AI to author or iterate on draft or published standards. The violation of this policy can result in the termination of CB membership.

A CB member may use the internet, to include AI to research topics related to or summarize information on a specific topic; in doing so:

- Content published on the internet or generated by AI shall not be pasted directly into a draft (i.e., CB member(s) and/or CB shall create the content).
- Content authored by the CB shall not be 'substantially similar' to content published on the internet or generated by AI.
- Prompts or inquiry in using generative AI shall be general in nature, and shall not include the titles of IICRC Standards and publication numbers (e.g., S100, S500, etc).
- Prompts or enquiries shall never include draft or published language from an IICRC document.

The resulting information may be considered by the CB when drafting content in a Standard, however the CB members shall author and take responsibility for the resultant content.

All AI tools are non-human and therefore cannot be listed as authors due to their inability to take responsibility or manage copyright. If generative AI tools have been used to research or summarize information that the Consensus Body (CB) member used to author content, they shall disclose to such to the CB.

Reviewers are not permitted to use AI. Creating derivative works from IICRC's Intellectual Property using AI is strictly prohibited.

For Standards Subscription Site and Webstore: Using Artificial Intelligence (AI) on IICRC standards and related intellectual property is prohibited. Violations will result in suspension of access.
